### Welcome to Mrs J Todd @Sutton

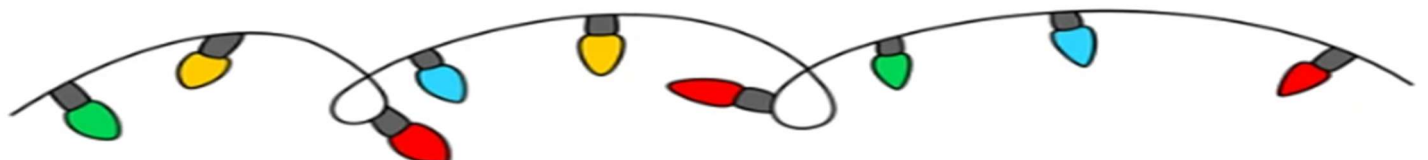
