The Launch of Arbor @Bugthorpe @Sutton

We have switched to Arbor for managing our school information; we have successfully taken our registers and done our dinner numbers this week. We are going to launch Arbor with parents on **Monday 15th April.** We will send you log in details and how to download the Arbor App.



The Arbor App will allow you to see your child's attendance, send in-app messages to your teacher, book and pay for wrap-around-care, as well as pay for school meals. With time, it will display behaviour notes and team point results, as well as attainment.

Please bear with us as we iron out any teething problems and find the answers to any questions; we are all learning to use it but I am confident it will be great as our main communication tool in the future. In the meantime, it would be worth keeping **Class Dojo** for its current purposes. We will let you know when we have fully switched over to Arbor for this.

As of midnight, on **Sunday 14th April**, you will no longer be able to use **School Comms at Bugthorpe** and **Tucasi at Sutton**. All of your credits and debits will be transferred to Arbor on Monday morning, before we launch the App to you. Arbor allows us to enter bank card payments. It is worth noting that before and after school clubs, as well as activity clubs, will need paying for in advance on Arbor (Sutton will no longer allow children to be booked into afterschool club ad hoc; you will need to book them in on Arbor; the same rule applies to Bugthorpe, replacing School Comms – thanks).

SIAMS Inspection 2024/25 @Sutton

As expected, Sutton will be inspected next academic year for SIAMS (Church school inspection). We look forward to celebrating how we live as a church school and showing the inspector what it is like to be a part of our loving school family. Our vision at Sutton is based on Proverbs, from the Old Testament: If you teach a child to be on the right path, they will continue on it when they are an adult. This is obviously what we are all about; we want our pupils to 'follow their pathway and grow with confidence'. Bugthorpe had a very positive inspection in October 2023, and because we work so closely, I expect to see similar comments at Sutton.



Facilities Update @Sutton

This week, we met with the Head of Children's Services for the East Riding; we gave them a tour of the school and they saw first-hand our facilities. It was identified that, with rising numbers, and a healthy projection for the future, our school hall does not meet the basic needs for the size of our school. We also discussed parking, the front entrance lobby, the size of our playground and the condition of our portacabin. We are hopeful that we can be added to a list of potential schools to be upgraded in the coming years, but are realistic to the limited funds available nationwide. Fingers crossed though; the meeting was positive, and they are going away to look at costings and whether or not the work is affordable.

Facilities Update @Bugthorpe

Within the next year, we are hoping to revamp the toilets in the Class 1 area. They are in need of modernisation and we are hoping to brighten them up and make the flushing system and taps easier for the children to use.

We are also looking into the soundproofing of Class 3. The folding wall that separates the hall from the classroom is very thin and having spent some time in
