Annual School Reports @Sutton @Bugthorpe

School reports will be issued next Thursday. Those children in school will bring this home with them; those children at home will receive it in the post.

School reports will obviously be slightly different this year. We are using the attendance figures from 1st September 2019 until Friday 14th February 2020. Teachers have made professional judgement on progress and attainment up until the school closure, due to Covid-19. We cannot offer any judgement as to whether or not they would have achieved the National 'Expected Standard' for their individual year groups; no National tests went ahead this year.

School Closure for the Summer @Sutton @Bugthorpe

Both schools will close for the summer holidays on Thursday 16th July 2020. We will reopen again to the children on Wednesday 9th September 2020.

The Government's plan is for all children to return to school in September in their normal class sizes. The guidance and logistics regarding this have not been published. When this has been made available to schools, I will be in touch to let you know how we will reopen (e.g. if we need staggered drop offs/pick ups, school meals, before and after school clubs etc).
