Have a wonderful Summer! @Bugthorpe @Sutton

On behalf of the staff teams, I would like to wish everyone a wonderful summer break. Thank you for all your support and patience, in what has been a difficult year. We have mastered Covid-19 risk assessments, 'bubbles', staggered drop offs, Lockdowns, live lessons and Seesaw/Tapestry parental engagement. We have missed face-to-face Collective Worships, playing together, sharing resources, normal school day routines/hours and eating together. September, however, is seeming far more hopeful. The latest, ever-changing, guidance suggests 'bubbles' will end and, therefore, the normal school hours will resume. We will keep you updated as the picture becomes clearer.

Government Guidance Update @Bugthorpe @Sutton

Following the country's move to Step 4, schools have been given the following guidance regarding September 2021:

- Guidance mentions that schools will need an 'Outbreak Management Plan' – we are awaiting further information about this from ERYC.
- No 'bubbles' needed this means that we say goodbye to staggered drop offs/pick ups, play and dinner times.
- We must maintain appropriate cleaning regimes. Twice a day with focus on touched surfaces.
- Hand washing must be continued This can be done with soap and water or hand sanitiser.

- Ventilation of rooms in use to continue ensuring a comfortable teaching environment is maintained.
- PPE not required beyond what would normally be needed. e.g. no face masks.
- The 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach continues to be very important.

It is probably best to address this with you again, before the start of next academic year, as I am sure further guidance will be published. We will contact you with any changes if needed. If we do not contact you, then you can assume that the normal school hours will resume (9-3:30pm for all classes).
