On behalf of the Governing Body, and both schools, I would like to thank Mr Edwards for all of his positive contributions into helping us come together and federate.

We therefore have a vacancy, for a Parent Governor to join the federated Governing Body. More details on how to apply have been shared via the School Office.

The role entails supporting the schools in moving forward together as we 'follow our pathway and grow with confidence'. We have 3 Full Governing Body meetings a year, which usually run from 6 – 8:30pm. We have two sub-committees, which governors can join – these are: Finance, Staffing and Resources and Teaching and Learning. The sub-committees meet 3 times per year and the meetings usually take place during the school day. These have been happening on Microsoft Teams; however, when Covid allows, the Teaching and Learning committee would meet in person so that they can get to see our work in action, by looking around our school provision, following our discussions.

If more than one parent, would like to become our new Parent Governor, then it would go to a parental vote, and the person with the most votes would be elected to the Governing Body.
