developing their creative flair in a practical day, as well as learning communication, team work and social skills.



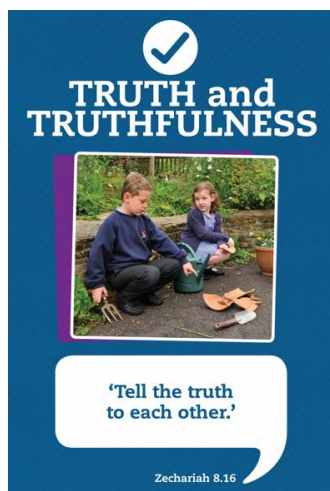

Miss Banks has made a difference to the lives of our children for 6 and a half years; passing on her passion for reading and creative writing and helping so many children on their pathways through school.

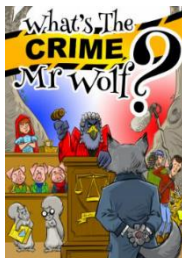

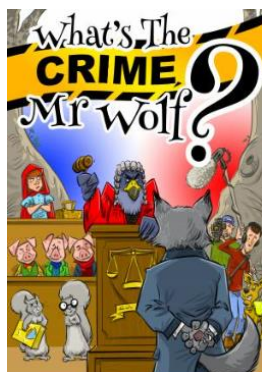
**Bugthorpe's Got Talent @Bugthorpe**
