#### Class Dojo @Bugthorpe @Sutton


You should have received an invite this week (paper copy) to sign up as a parent to Class Dojo. We are

trialling Class Dojo to replace Seesaw (home school communication tool for Years 1-6) and potentially Tapestry (EYFS learning journey), however this is not confirmed yet so please keep the Tapestry app. It is all new to us,



but since the pandemic, we have adapted well to new technologies. Class Dojo allows school to share pictures of what your child has done that day, and allows you to contact your class teacher If needed. It also has the added benefit of collecting our Team Points! It will make totalling up the scores so much easier for our Vice Captains © Please use Class Dojo from now on and remove the Seesaw app for the time being. ### Aligning our Long Term Plans @Bugthorpe @Sutton



When I started in September 2019, we only had a curriculum planned until Christmas 2019. Class 3 at Sutton were doing 'rivers' for 15 weeks; how could we engage the children for that length of time unless we were kayaking up a river or digging our own life-size model on the school field....

We launched our current curriculum, across the Federation in January 2020, which was slightly impacted by Covid-19. The problem we have encountered is that classes across the schools were not aligned, as some classes had previously taught certain topics and, therefore, were teaching on different years of our two-year cycle.

This September, 2023, we aim to ensure that all four classes start the process to align, so that teachers can plan together, share resources and ideas, arrange more joint educational visits, and utilise our minibus for learning together in one space. Class 4 have already been fortunate to be aligned, and we have seen the benefits of this, with Mr Price and Mrs Garcia working closely on the same topic each half term. For our alignment to work, Classes 2 and 3 at Sutton will follow a slightly different (1 year only) plan, which we are working to create next half term as a staff team. Hopefully, all classes will be working on Year A of our two-year cycle.
