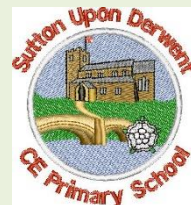

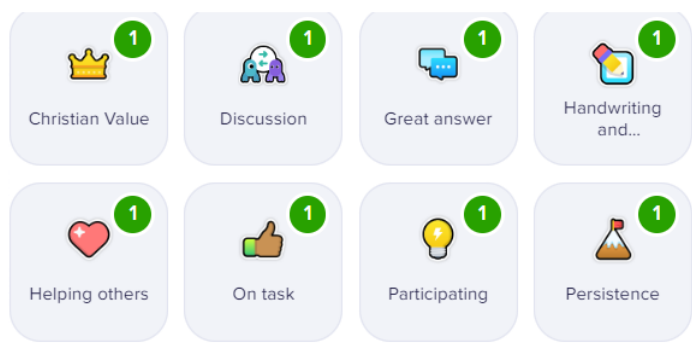
Bugthorpe's Production is on Friday 14th July at 2pm
